



Classroom Charter – COVID-19

To help reduce the risk of spread of COVID 19 Ballard has set out a number of expectations for pupils to adhere to within the classroom.

- Pupils must keep a social distance of 2 metres at all times.
- Pupils must follow the one-way system as explained by your teacher
- Pupils will be expected to sanitise their hands on entering and leaving the classroom
- Pupils will remain in their own groups at all times during the school day
- Pupils will follow the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' rule when sneezing and coughing and put tissues in the designated lidded tissue bin
- If pupils do not have a tissue (these will be provided in all classrooms) then they must sneeze / cough into their elbow
- Pupils will avoid touching their mouth, nose and eyes with their hands.
- Pupils must stay in their designated seats and not walk around the classroom – put your hand up if you need support from your teacher
- Pupils must not share resources with another pupil
- Pupils will use their designated toilets and will visit the toilet one at a time
- Pupils must wash their hands with soap and water after visiting the toilet and dry them with paper towels
- Pupils will not cough or spit at or towards any other person.
- Pupils will not deliberately touch another person.
- Windows and doors are to be kept open to allow airflow in the classroom
- Pupils must bring their own headphones to school to effectively use their computers
- Pupils must not drink from the water fountain. Pupils must only fill their water bottle from the tall spouted water fountain in the Senior block or PAC kitchen
- Pupils must wash their hands before and after eating
- Pupils must tell an adult if they are experiencing symptoms of Coronavirus

Symptoms of Coronavirus

- High temperature
- New continuous cough
- Loss or change to your sense of smell or taste
