Nursery and Kindergarten Fact Sheet

Welcome to our award-winning Nursery and Kindergarten for children aged two to four years old.

Term Times and Hours

Ballard's Nursery & Kindergarten are open **34** weeks a year during term-time. You may find our term dates [here](#).

The minimum number of sessions per week, excluding early or late club, are:

- Nursery – 4 sessions
- Kindergarten – 5 sessions

Our sessions are:

- 08.30 – 16.00 – charge for lunch
- 08.30 – 13.00 – charge for lunch
- 08.30 – 12.00 – No lunch
- 12.30 – 16.00 – No lunch
- 13.00 – 16.00 – No lunch
- 08.00 – 08.30 – Early club
- 16.00 – 17.00 – Late club

Fees

From September 2025, the charge for non-funded hours is **£9.94** per hour and the consumable charge for funded hours is **£2.06**. Our fees include all snacks during the day, with our delicious hot lunch only costing **£4.79**. All fees are paid a term in advance.

Funded Hours

- For children who are 2 years old, we will accept **30 hours per week** offered by Hampshire County Council (HCC) for working parents. Please note that for all Local Authority funding, parents must provide an eligibility code to claim these hours.
- For children who are aged 3 and 4 years old (term after 3rd birthday), we will accept the universal hours of **15 hours per week** offered from HCC. We will also accept the

extended **15 hours per week** for working parents offered from HCC and again we will require an eligibility code for this.

Please note that it is the parents, rather than the school, that applies for the additional funding. We recommend that you allow plenty of time for the process so that you can provide the code in good time. Further criteria can be found on the Government website when you apply for the funding.

Please also note that Ballard School only offer 34 weeks entitlement out of the maximum 38 weeks. You may access the remainder of the free entitlement at another approved provider.

Staffing Ratios

Ballard follows the government guidelines for Early Years ratios, although these ratios may be lower at any one session.

These is a maximum of one adult to five (1:5) children for 2-year-olds.

For 3- and 4-year-olds, the ratio changes to one adult to eight (1:8) children.

When a qualified teacher is working with the 3 and 4-year-old children, the ratio may increase to a maximum of one adult to thirteen (1:13) children.

The Admissions Process

Enquiry & Visit

We are always happy to show you and your family around our Nursery and Kindergarten during term-time. You will be able to view all our facilities, visit the classrooms, meet the Early Years Practitioners and find out more about why our parents call us 'Simply the best school every day.' Registration and Settling in Session

We ask that all parents register their children in good time so that we can help you secure all the sessions that suit you best. The registration process is simple and there is a fee of £50 payable at this point. Once registered, we will invite you and your child in for a settling in session.

The aim of this session is to not only familiarise your child with their new environment but also to find out more about them. It is so important to discuss a number of topics with you at this point to ensure that we can help your child feel secure and happy when they start with us. Useful information includes what their favourite toys are, their sleep patterns, and their interests. After this conversation we will invite you to leave your child with us for half an hour, so that they can explore the learning environments independently.

We will book this session in shortly before your child is due to start our Nursery or Kindergarten. Please note that we can only offer settling in sessions on the day of the child's second birthday or when they are already two years old.
